Viewpoint 1: Approximately 180° panoramic view from US Route 7, adjacent to the northwestern corner of the Project parcel, panning from north (left) to south (right) across the Project site. The orange rectangle left of the center of the panoramic view represents the image below, which is captured with a normal lens, equivalent to the human ‘field of view’.



Viewpoint 1: View looking southeast from US Route 7 towards the Project site, as represented by the orange rectangle in the panoramic view above.



Viewpoint 2: Approximately 180° panoramic view from US Route 7, adjacent to the southwestern corner of the Project parcel, panning from north (left) to south (right) across the Project site. The orange rectangle left of the center of the panoramic view represents the image below, which is captured with a normal lens, equivalent to the human ‘field of view’.

Viewpoint 3: Approximately 180° panoramic view from southern lookout and picnic area at summit of Mt. Philo. The orange rectangle left of the center of the panoramic view represents the image below, which is captured with a normal lens, equivalent to the human ‘field of view’.



Viewpoint 3: View looking west from southern lookout at Mt. Philo summit, as represented by the orange rectangle in the panoramic view above. No visibility of the Project was observed.



Viewpoint 4: Approximately 180° panoramic view from large lookout adjacent to the main picnic area at the summit of Mt. Philo, panning from approximately southeast (left) to northwest (right). The orange rectangle left of the center of the panoramic view represents the image below, which is captured with a normal lens, equivalent to the human ‘field of view’.



Viewpoint 4: View looking west from Mt. Philo summit at the Project site, as represented by the orange rectangle in the panoramic view above.



Viewpoint 5: Approximately 180° panoramic view from main summit lookout on Mt. Philo, panning from southeast (left) to northwest (right). The orange rectangle left of the center of the panoramic view represents the image below, which is captured with a normal lens, equivalent to the human ‘field of view’.

Viewpoint 6: Approximately 180° panoramic view from lower lookout, west of Mt. Philo summit, panning from south (left) to north (right) across the Project site.
