PETITION FOR THE USE OF THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY

Now come Waitsfield and Champlain Valley Telecom, and Green Mountain Power Corporation, Petitioners, and respectfully represent that in order to furnish adequate service to their patrons, it is necessary to replace/install eight (8) poles and five (5) anchors within the highway limits of the Town of Charlotte as shown on the attached plan. The project covered by this agreement is further described as follows:

Waitsfield and Champlain Valley Telecom and Green Mountain Power propose to replace seven (7) poles and install one (1) mid-span pole along Lake Road as highlighted on the attached plan, labeled job# 139586. The poles to be replaced are poles tagged 706781, 706779, 6288-92 and the pole to be added is tagged 706775. The locations have been reviewed with Hugh Lewis Jr.

The Petitioners further represent that such work will be done in accordance with the plans and specifications attached, the special conditions so noted on this agreement, and in a manner safe for public travel and subject to the rules thereof. In consideration for this agreement, the Petitioners will, without expense to the Town, repair said line should it be accidentally damaged in the normal course of road repairs, maintenance and/or improvements. It is further agreed that the Petitioners will restore the town highway, if damaged, to its original condition within five days of cable and/or pole replacement or repair, weather and conditions permitting.

Wherefore, the Petitioners, in accordance with 30 V.S.A. §2502, request approval from the Selectboard to replace and locate the poles as aforesaid.
