

## **Map: UVM Cycling Road Race, April 2<sup>nd</sup> 2017**

**Parking:** lot at the corner of Church Hill Rd. and Route 7

**Police car 1:** A police officer will control traffic, and allow racers and pace/follow vehicles to proceed onto Church Hill Rd when it is safe to do so.

**Marshal point: Charlotte Congregational Church:** Marshal will aid motorists and pedestrians to get to and leave from the Congregational Church without impeding the racers on course. (Only necessary during the starts of the two waves of road races)

**Marshal point: Church Hill and Hinesburg:** Marshal will direct racers to continue right onto Hinesburg Rd from Church Hill Rd.

**Police car 2: Hinesburg and Philo:** Marshal will aid with traffic when races start. Police officer will be at intersection of Hinesburg Rd & Mt. Philo Rd to control traffic. Race will initially proceed straight across Mt. Philo Rd eastbound. After starts race will approach intersection from the south on Mt. Philo Rd, to take a right onto Hinesburg Rd eastbound. Marshal will guide racers to make the correct turn.

**Police car 3: Hinesburg and Spear:** Racers will approach intersection from the west on Hinesburg Rd, and make a right turn onto Spear St. Police officer will be at intersection to control traffic. One marshal will inform officer when riders are approaching intersection. Another marshal will guide racers to make the correct turn.

**Marshal point: Mt. Carmel Church:** Marshal will aid motorists and pedestrians to get to and leave from the Mount Carmel Catholic Church without impeding the racers on course.

**Marshal point: Spear and Monkton:** Racers will approach intersection from the northeast on Spear St, and bear right continuing on Spear St. Marshal will guide racers to make the correct turn.

**Police car 4: Spear and Philo:** Racers will approach intersection from the northeast on Spear St, and make a right turn onto Mt. Philo Rd northbound. Police officer will be at intersection to control traffic. Marshal will guide racers to make the correct turn.

**Ambulance:** An ambulance from CVFRS will be stationed on standby in the Mt. Philo parking lot, for immediate availability in the event of a crash.
