Dorothy suggested that the meadow east of the hedgerow south of Snowdrift Lane be designated a wildlife meadow. The area is currently part of the agricultural lease, but has not been used in recent years. The field tends to be wet. Mike LaClair planned to reseed the field this year. Committee members concluded that it could be managed as a wildlife area if Mike is not interested in using the field.

Approval of purchases with remaining 2015-16 budget funds

Jenny was authorized to make purchases using remaining budget funds – gravel for trails, herbicide, tools for volunteers.

Project updates

Mark provided updates on the elm tree grant and the emerald ash borer. He will be working on an inventory of ash trees in town.
