Re: Appeal of Bennett and Naritomi concerning Administrator's October 23, 2017 letter

Dear Mr. Chairman,

I write on behalf of Stuart Bennett and Patricia Naritomi in regards to their appeal. Upon reviewing the history of correspondence and appeals, there is no longer a need to continue the Bennett/Naritomi appeal.

Mr. Bennett's initial request to the Town on March 7, 2018 asked that Mr. Dean Bloch file Mr. Rheume's October 23, 2017 letter as a "decision" by March 15, 2018. By letter, of March 15, 2018 Dean Bloch did as requested. Mr. Minkler then appealed Mr. Rheume's determination and Mr. Bloch's letter on March 27, 2018. This is the operative appeal the ZBA needs to address and therefore Mr. Bennett and Ms. Naritomi withdraw their appeal.

In considering Mr. Minklers' appeal, Mr. Bennett and Ms. Naritomi trust that the ZBA will consider the criteria contained in the Charlotte Land Use Regulations and go forward with the scheduled site visit as it will allow the Minklers' and the ZBA to place the issues previously discussed into physical context.
