To the town planner,

My husband John Creech and I have concerns regarding the Donovan subdivision. We will attend the meeting tonight as adjoining land owners.

Our concerns are that the large number of lots in this area could have an impact on the movement of wildlife through what we have seen as a wildlife corridor between this vast area and the Charlotte park land. We have heard the coyotes, the owls and seen bobcat on numerous occasions in the 32 years that we have lived in our house.

We are concerned about the proximity of the development to Holmes Brook and the impact on the wet lands and water quality flowing towards the lake.

Greenbush Road has been noted as a scenic roadway and such an extensive development would change the landscape in this area including impacts during the day and night.

We will be curious to read the report and see what unfolds tonight at the meeting.
