- 3) Food shelf weatherization project.
 - a) We've created a google form for Charlotters to sign up for EV's Button Up home consultations. A direct mailing with the information will go to mobile homes based on the Grand List info shared by EV.
 - b) We've done outreach for interns with no response so far. Possibility of reaching out on FPF for students who are unexpectedly home studying remotely.
 - c) EAN has invited pitches for its summit in Oct; Deirdre's group Climate Catalysts has pitched an idea for a Vermont Climate Corps. (Folks can register for the summit, Oct 1-2.)
 - d) We need to get Matt Sargent to teach us how to use the thermal camera.
- 4) Review budget that was approved for FY 20-21. Possible additional or replacement items: solar monitor at library; educational signage re efficiency measures at library; Conservation Corner additions such as subscriptions; signage for the EV charger.
