Approve plan for bog bridge project

After researching several options, Jessie recommended that we have James Bell rebuild the bog bridges in the area by the big oak tree. He can do the work for around \$3000, including materials. This includes \$30/ hr. for labor for two people over two days, \$175 for delivery costs, \$75/hr. for use of his skidsteer, and lumber from LSF Forest Products, LLC at \$1296. Clifford Lumber could not supply hemlock.

Jenny made a motion, seconded by Dorothy to approve this plan and to use \$500 in donated funds (in Thorp Barn Fund) for the project. The motion was passed.
