


NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF TOWN OF CHARLOTTE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS ORDINANCE

The Selectboard of the Town of Charlotte hereby ordains:


Pursuant to the provisions of 20 V.S.A. § 39(e) and 24 V.S.A. §§ 2291 and 1971 et seq., and other such general enactments as may be material thereto, the Town of Charlotte (the "Town") hereby adopts a Hazardous Materials Ordinance. This Ordinance requires those in possession of any hazardous materials to prevent their discharge or release and to assure that any hazardous materials are used in a manner that will prevent their escape from containment. The Ordinance further provides that individuals in possession of hazardous materials are strictly liable to the Town or a designated entity for all costs incurred in the control, containment and cleanup of any hazardous materials that have been discharged or released, as well as providing penalties in the event of a discharge or release of hazardous materials in the Town.




