Pursuant to Title 24 §2509 V.S.A., the Charlotte Tree Warden will hold a public hearing on October 24th, 2019 at 5:30 p.m. at the Charlotte Town Hall to consider the proposed removal of 11 trees on State Park Road. This is to facilitate the creation of a public trail along this section of road. The trees are marked with green flagging to facilitate public assessment. Note that in its current proposal the Trails Committee has located the trail so as to minimize tree removals in the public right-of-way and to avoid removals of trees identified in the previous assessment as significant. A list of trees to be removed is available from the Tree Warden upon request.
