



Here are two maps. In looking at the history of the lot, I think a subdivision amendment is probably the easiest path to take. One map shows a "blue" outline, a "black" outline, and a "purple" outline. The combination of the blue and black are the portion to be combined for the amendment. Acreages are on the lower right hand corner. The balance of that lot is to be added to the 10 acre lot on which my house sits, shown on the other map in red. I would have combined the two maps to make things simple but google does not support the ANR maps and when I use internet explorer to access the site, I get a ton of cookies and malware along with the map.
