



Pease Mountain Trail

LENGTH 2.6 miles (network) RATING Easy to Moderate

SURFACE Packed Dirt USES 

DIRECTIONS Located behind the Charlotte Central School on Hinesburg Rd. Park between the metal maintenance shed and the school. Walk across the athletic fields and up the hill to an informational sign marking the trailhead.

NOTES The trail is composed of an upper and lower loop, with two spur trails on the upper loop leading to scenic views. Be mindful on the lower loop; there are a few trails that lead to nearby homes.



Williams Woods

Trail maintained by The Nature Conservancy

LENGTH 1.2 miles (loop) RATING Easy

SURFACE Packed Dirt, Boardwalk USES 

DIRECTIONS From the Charlotte west village center, drive two miles south on Greenbush Road, and then veer left. Be sure to stay left on Greenbush Road as it continues to the south (if you come to a railroad crossing, you've mistakenly turned off onto Thompsons Point Rd). Travel about one mile further on Greenbush until you come to a green Williams Woods sign and the parking area on the right.

NOTES Please stay on the trails. No pets please.



Town Link Trail


LENGTH 1.8 miles (one-way)

RATING Easy

SURFACE Gravel

USES

DIRECTIONS To reach parking for the Co-housing section of the Town Link Trail, from the Charlotte west village center, drive south on Greenbush Rd. for 1.3 miles. Turn east onto Common Way. In about 0.3 miles there is a sign directing you to a parking area on the left. Park your car, then continue walking east on Common Way for a few minutes. On the right you will see the entrance for the trail marked by a Town Link Trail sign.



Charlotte Park and Wildlife Refuge

LENGTH 3.1 miles (network)


RATING Easy

SURFACE Packed Dirt, Gravel

USES

DIRECTIONS Take Rt. 7 to Ferry Road and go towards the Charlotte town center. Make a right at the flashing red light to go north on Greenbush Rd. After 1.3 miles the parking area will be on your right.

NOTES Park is open from 8am to 30 minutes after sunset. No pets please.



Plouffe Lane

LENGTH 1.4 miles (network)

RATING Easy to Moderate

SURFACE Packed Dirt, Grass

USES

DIRECTIONS Take Spear St. or Dorset St. to Carpenter Rd. Off of Carpenter Rd. take Plouffe Ln. to the end (there is a red gate), open the gate and park your car inside.

NOTES Please respect the homeowners on Plouffe Lane by obeying the speed limit and all posted signs.
